We will pay you to attend a two-day training session and a two-hour observation shift, to prepare you for paid work on Lifeline's national crisis line. You will also receive access to Lifeline's exclusive and comprehensive eLearning program.

You will not only become an accredited Lifeline Crisis Supporter, you will have guaranteed work on either our 11.00pm – 6.00am or midnight – 6.00am shifts.

Overnight shifts are very busy, with constant calls from people in crisis. Offering skilled, caring support during these hours is a vital part of our service, and you will be assisting many help-seekers at high risk.

Our intake process starts on 12 July, and the face-to-face training will be held at our Gordon office on Sat 7 August and Sun 8 August, from 9.30am to 5.00pm.
